



Residential Recycling Collection Rules

- Set out by 7 a.m. on the morning of your collection day.
- Lid must be closed & cart placed at alley edge or driveway flares.
- Placed at least 3' from nearest object.
- All recyclables must be inside recycle cart.
- All paper items must be free of food or toxic contamination.
- All food and beverage cans must be empty and rinsed clean. Can lids must be placed inside cans.
- Remove caps and lids from glass containers and discard. All glass must be empty and rinsed clean.

Items that can be recycled

- **Mixed Paper** * Newspapers/magazines/mail/junk mail * phone/paperback books/cardboard * **Cans** * Steel food cans/aluminum beverage cans/aerosol cans(empty) * **Glass** * Food and beverage containers * clear, green, and brown/no plate glass, please * **Plastic** * Yard waste in plastic bags will **NOT** be collected.

ID is Required. A copy of TX drivers license and current copy of The Colony Utility Bill. Apartment renters call 972-624-3132 for alternatives in lieu of Utility Bill. No more than 5 gallons of any product, except oil based paint (10 Gallons allowed)
